### TOWN OF GORHAM RESOLUTION #13-2025 AUTHORIZING SCHEDULING OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO GORHAM WATER DISTRICT #1

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Gorham, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interests of the Town to schedule a public hearing, pursuant to § 202-b of the NYS Town Law, to solicit public comment upon proposed improvements to the Town Water Treatment Plant, which is owned and operated by the Gorham Water District #1; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Engineer has prepared a map and plan showing the proposed improvements being the construction of an ultrafiltration plant that would consist of the construction of a new Filter Building and an Equalization Tank of various sizes and which would replace the existing DE filters and UV system; and

**WHEREAS,** the plan shows the estimated costs of these improvements to be \$14,750,000.00, such estimated costs to be the responsibility of Gorham Water District #1; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town applied for a NYSEFC grant administered through its NYS Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) program to pay for part of the cost of these improvements and was awarded \$3,000,000.00; and

**WHEREAS,** any remaining amount owing for these improvements will be borrowed from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund and financed and repaid by the owners of property within the Gorham Water District #1.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby is, directed to schedule a public hearing, to be held on July 16, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Gorham Town Hall, 4736 South Street, Gorham, New York; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk, be and hereby is, directed to forward to the official newspapers of the Town a Notice of Public Hearing in the form substantially the same as that attached hereto as Exhibit "1", such notice to be published not less than ten nor more than twenty days before the day set herein for the public hearing; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby is, directed to post a copy of the Notice of Public Hearing on the Town of Gorham sign board, not less than ten nor more than twenty days before the day set herein for the public hearing.

## TOWN OF GORHAM RESOLUTION #14-2025 PARTICIPATE IN A COOPERATIVE NATURAL GAS BID BY BOCES For the Period 10/01/2025 – 09/30/2026

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Gorham NY desires to participate in a Cooperative Bidding Program conducted by the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties from year to year or, until this resolution is rescinded, for the purchase for supply of natural gas, and;

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Gorham NY is desirous of participating with the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties in the joint bid of the commodities and/or services mentioned below as authorized by General Municipal Law, Section 119-o, and;

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Gorham NY has appointed the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties as representative to assume the responsibility for drafting of specifications, advertising for bids, accepting and opening bids, tabulating bids, reporting the results to the Town of Gorham NY and making recommendations thereon;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town of Gorham NY and the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties hereby accepts the appointment of the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties to represent it in all matters related above and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town of Gorham NY authorizes the above-mentioned Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties to represent it in all matters regarding the entering into contract for the purchase of the belowmentioned commodities and/or services and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, The Town of Gorham NY agrees to assume its equitable share of the costs incurred as a result of the cooperative bidding and;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Town Supervisor, on behalf of the Town of Gorham NY, is hereby authorized to participate in cooperative bidding conducted by the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties for supply of natural gas and, if requested, to furnish an estimated minimum number of units that will be purchased by the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties. The Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Ontario, Seneca, Wayne and Yates Counties is hereby authorized to award cooperative bids to the bidder deemed to be the lowest responsive and responsible meeting the bid specifications and otherwise complying with Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York relating to public bids and contracts.
